Is your Meeting keeping up with the 7th Tradition of being self-supporting?

Meetings are encouraged to distribute surplus funds on a quarterly basis to their Intergroup, to World Service (WSO), and to their Region.

OA suggests that meetings send 60 % of their surplus after expenses to their Intergroup, 30% to the WSO, and 10 % to the Region. For your convenience, New Hampshire Intergroup makes it possible for meetings to make contributions via credit card or bank account through PayPal. You do not have to have a PayPal account to make a contribution.
