<p>Answering Service Naisa</p>	<p>The Answering Service continues to receive very few calls per month which can be discouraging to volunteers because they still need to go through the process of checking for messages. I have been looking around for a less expensive and less volunteer intensive phone option that can deliver voicemail messages to an email inbox. I found one that is highly rated; that is a one-user standard office service that includes 1000 incoming minutes per month to the 800 number and unlimited conference calling for the board, (not toll free), and is capable of delivering voice messages to an email address. Neither the toll free number nor the local number would have to be changed, therefore the literature and website would not have to be changed. Then, one person could receive and disseminate messages to volunteers depending on the location of the caller, or to a board member if the call is regarding meeting changes, etc. The board will need to make a final decision on the new service, but at this early stage it looks like a viable option.</p> <p>Any questions can be directed to me at 603-630-9969 or Naisa.Chase@gmail.com</p>
