We asked for funds to have a banner printed, to put copies of OA reading literature in the libraries of all communities where OA meets; plus our neighbors: Londonderry and Hudson lies., and to have various literature in stock. The application was approved by the committee AND approved by the Region 6 Board. The award was announced at the end of the Spring Assembly. Hooray!! As a side note; yours truly – Eileen went to Spring Assembly as a delegate and was placed on the PIPO committee, and got to see a bit more of “just how Region works,” what a Region Assembly is like, and learned more about PIPO in general. As well as meeting many interesting people. Quite an experience; I would highly recommend it to anyone. We have an award of \$660; which must be spent by July 31 (end of region’s fiscal year).
